



In spite of the challenging political environment of this past year, the Lovering Health Center managed to maintain all of its current programming, including gynecological wellness visits, STD & STI screenings and treatment, and abortion care. The Lovering also experienced a 100% increase from 2021 to 2022 in patient visits to the clinic's Gender Affirming Transgender Care program.




